PART A:

1. Level 1 (identifies question)
2. Level 4 (explains own view)
3. Level 2 (bare 'agree'/'disagree')
4. Level 2 (bare 'agree'/'disagree')
5. Level 1 (identifies question)
6. Level 3 (gives own view)
7. Level 1 (identifies question)

PART B:

This is a matter of interpretation – you might reject them all! – but 3 ('Smart devices have transformed the relationship between built environment and exercise.') is the worthiest candidate for inclusion.

PART C:

Swap your efforts with a friend and see if you can pinpoint what level each introduction is at. As you read your friend's work, and review your own, consider the following:

- Can you easily spot what the essay take-home is?
- Can you cut any more fluff – background information that doesn't contribute directly to the argument?
- Does the introduction seem interesting? Does it make you want to read on?
